IGNITING AN INNOVATIVE SPARK IN TRAINING

The UA Piping Industry College of BC funded by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (H.R.S.D.C.) and the Industry Training Authority (I.T.A.) has developed an innovative new 6-month training program for Level "C" Welding which will revolutionize the way apprentices learn. 2-months of online theory and 4-months of in-shop practical training. (Note: Shop time for this program will be held in the afternoons)

By incorporating the "learn to learn" Essential Skills like Working with Others and Computer Use, participants in F.W.T will learn how to effectively process and retain information by using auditory and visual learning from thousands of photographs and hours of videos.

Participants will also have exclusive online assistance from instructors in a virtual classroom using chat rooms and discussion boards and will have the ability to review learning objectives on their own time and repeatedly if needed.

This innovative new program will allow participants to work from home, significantly reduce the amount of time needed for the theoretical portion of welding training and allow participants to complete assignments on their own time.
